We have been conducting various student voice activities on the new Kingsbury Green Academy PE kit, and have tried to find the best solution for both parents and students, that is affordable and flexible, but ultimately still smart and comfortable to wear. We really want a PE kit that the students are happy and proud to wear. The new PE kit is navy blue which matches the new colour scheme for the school. To this end, we have decided on a KGA branded, round neck top for all students across all year groups. We have also introduced a compulsory 'bottom half' to the new PE kit, but tried to give the students flexibility in what they can choose to wear. This means that students can choose one of four KGA branded items to wear with their round neck top. This includes a pair of shorts, a pair of tapered track suit bottoms, a skort, or a pair of athletic leggings. The new PE kit is gender neutral, so students can wear any of these items for the 'bottom half'.

For those students who are currently taking, or plan to take, Sports Science as an examination class, we have introduced a Kingsbury Green Polo shirt, as an optional item. Further details will be given to students taking Sports Science next week.
